Step 1: Find a recording device







If there isn't a dedicated recording device in the box, locate an iOS or Android device to record your session. This will need the IRIS Connect app installed on it.

Step 2: Attaching the stand

- 1. If the base fastener is tightened, turn it anticlockwise to loosen it.
- Place the stand in the desired location and tighten the fastener until it's securely attached to the table or shelf.





Step 3: Setting up the stand

- To extend the stand loosen the knob and adjust arms until they are in the desired position.
- Tighten knobs making sure the teeth on the cogs are interlocking so it can properly tighten
- 3. Bend the adjustable section of the stand to it's desired position.



Step 4: Pairing to the microphone

If you have previously paired to the microphone the microphone should pair automatically

- 1. Press and hold the M button for 2 seconds. The LED will flash and you will hear 'Power on' through the earpiece.
- You should hear 'Your phone is connected' through the earpiece, or see the Bluetooth battery icon in the status bar. You can also check if the microphone has paired via your device's Bluetooth menu.

If the microphone hasn't paired, see the pairing guide on the right.



Step 5: Attach microphone and device

- 1. Clip the microphone to your clothing or use the lanyard provided.
- 2. Place your recording device on the stand using the adjustable holder.

Please make sure your device is in landscape orientation

Pairing to the Microphone

- 1. Plug the earpiece into the microphone.
- Press and hold the M button for 5 seconds until you hear "Pairing".
- 3. Navigate to your device's Bluetooth settings menu.
- On your device, turn on Bluetooth and select DSIT-022 from the list of available Bluetooth devices.
- When paired, you will hear "Your phone is connected".
- 6. You can now unplug the earpiece.

- Flashing red and blue Pairing mode
- ① Flashing Blue Paired

Battery level guide:

To check the battery level of the microphone, review the icon on the device its paired to, which indicates the remaining battery charge.



Charging LED Guide

- Solid red, then flash Charging
- Solid blue Fully charged
- Flashing red and blue Paired and charging
