Step 1: Find a recording device







If there isn't a dedicated recording device in the box, locate an iOS or Android device to record your session. This will need the IRIS Connect Record app installed on it.

Step 2: Attaching the stand

- 1. If the base fastener is tightened, turn it anticlockwise to loosen it
- 2. Place the stand in the desired location and tighten the fastener until it's securely attached to the table or shelf





Step 3: Setting up the stand

- To extend the stand loosen the knob and adjust arms until they are in the desired position
- 2. Tighten knobs making sure the teeth on the cogs are interlocking so it can properly tighten
- 3. Bend the adjustable section of the stand to it's desired position





Step 4: Connecting to the microphone

If you have previously paired your device to the microphone, follow the steps below.

- 1. Make sure Bluetooth is turned on on your device
- 2. Press and hold the Θ button for 2 seconds to turn the microphone on
- 3. The indicator light on the microphone will now flash slowly to show it is connected





If the microphone hasn't paired, you may need to follow Step 4 from the pairing guide on the right.

Step 5: Final step-up and recording

- 1. Clip the microphone to your clothing or use the lanyard provided
- 2. Place your recording device on the stand using the adjustable holder

Please make sure your device is in landscape orientation





3. Launch the IRIS Connect Record app on your device and follow the on-screen instructions

After recording, make sure your reflection has uploaded from your device

Dont forget to charge the microphone and turn if off before returning it to the case (To turn off the microphone, press the button for 4 seconds until you see a red light, then release)

Pairing to the microphone

- When pairing to your device for the first time make sure the distance between the device and microphone is less than 1 meter
- Press and hold the power button
 ⊕ on the
 side of the microphone for 4 seconds until the
 white indicator light starts flashing quicky
- Navigate to your device's Bluetooth settings
 menu
- On your device, turn on Bluetooth and select Baseus BA03 from the list of available Bluetooth devices
- 5. Your device should now show the status as 'Connected'

Indicator light guide

- Fast flashing white Pairing mode
- Slow flashing white Paired
- : Flashing white Paired: Sending data
- Solid red Charging
- Single red Powering off
- Single white Powering on

Battery level guide

To check the battery level of the microphone, review the icon on the device its paired to, which indicates the remaining battery charge.



Battery level indicator

One light on: 0%-25% of power
Two lights on: 25%-66.6% of power
Three lights on: 66.6%-100% of power
